By-Laws

## **SUBJECT: DUTIES OF SCHOOL PHYSICIAN**

The School Physician shall be appointed annually by the Board of Education. The duties of the School Physician shall include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a) To perform professional medical services in the examination and care of school children;
- b) To make periodic examinations of school children to detect the presence of contagious diseases and physical defects;
- c) To serve as a member on the Committee on the Handicapped;
- d) To report to the Board on school health services and on the condition of school buildings in regard to health and safety;
- e) To coordinate scheduling for physical examinations to all pupils participating in interscholastic athletics;
- f) To develop the program of health service in accordance with policies approved by the Board and as directed by the Superintendent of Schools.
- g) To conduct physical exams for all bus drivers and substitutes annually (prior to employment).
- h) To conduct a physical/mental exam on any employee at the request of the Board of Education.
