## **SUBJECT: PUBLIC COMPLAINTS**

The Board recognizes the right of individuals and groups to present complaints concerning school personnel, the curriculum, or instructional materials, or concerning school services and school facilities.

The Board encourages parents and other citizens to express their concerns, to ask questions, and to take an active interest in the schools' educational program and school environment by attending Board meetings, visiting the schools, and meeting with teachers.

Complaints should be processed through the school personnel involved and the superintendent prior to being brought to the Board of Education.
